Nothing is closer to our image of *The Garden of Eden* than the **Tropics!**



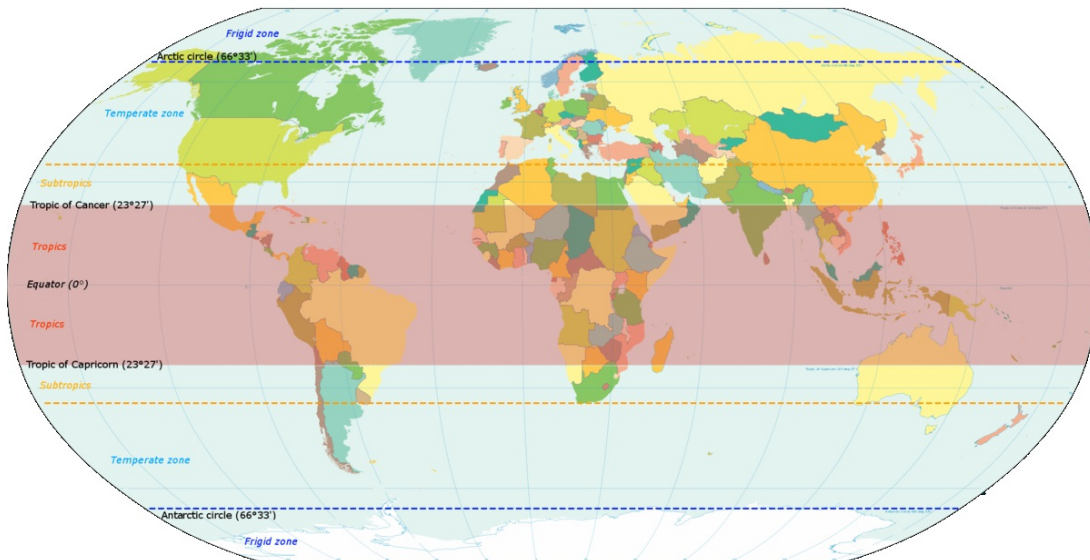
Garden of Eden on earth?

*This theme led some scholars, including Gourou, to argue that warmer climates correlate to primitive indigenous populations lacking control over nature, compared to northern populations having "mastered nature" " ([wikipedia](#))*

No region on earth holds such a huge promise and potential for agriculture as the tropics do!

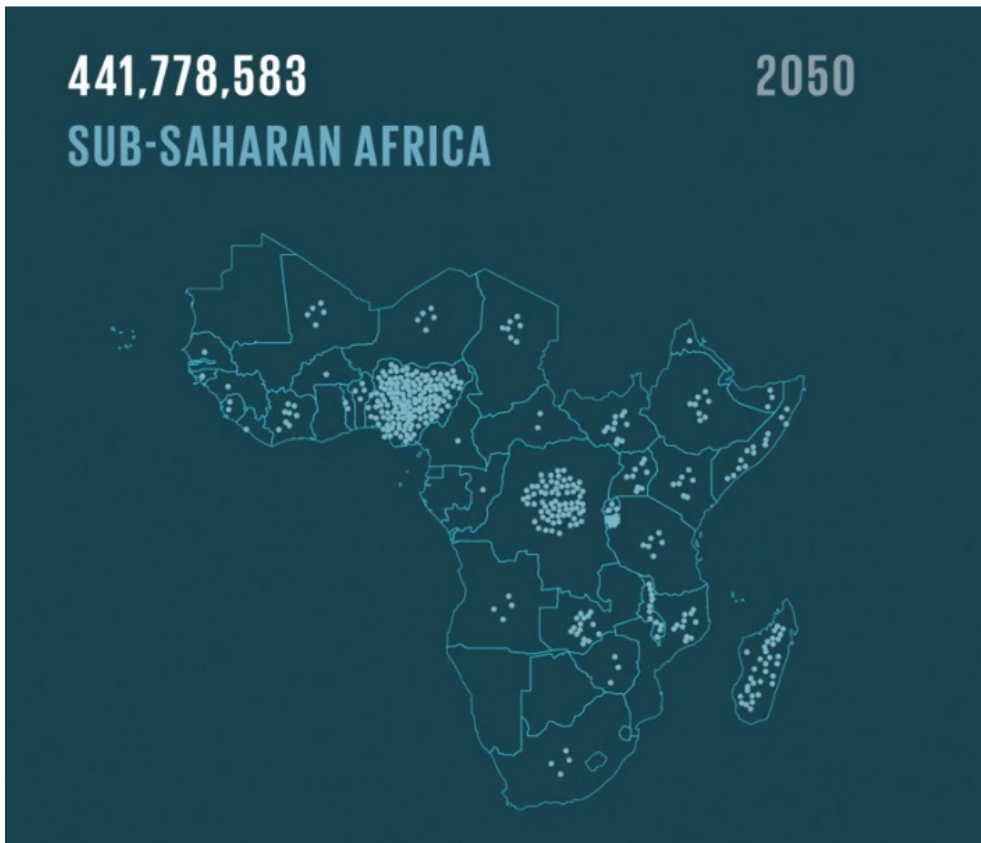
"The tropics comprise 40% of the Earth's surface area and contain 36% of the Earth's landmass".

"As of 2014, the region is home to **40% of the world population**, and this figure is projected to reach **50%** by the late 2030s" ([wikipedia](#))

Much of the population in the tropics are farmers, dependent on agriculture for food as well as economic security.

Having enough sunlight, land, water and available labor this population should, theoretically, thrive.

However, in reality, much of the world poorest population live in the tropics and suffer from poverty and hunger.

By the end of this century, nearly half of the newborn babies will be born in Sub-Saharan countries. Many of which will be born into a world of poverty, unless we act and change it now.
